We have received your request regarding Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) on the large range of products that you purchase from Kendall. MSDS are enclosed for those products that require them (annotated on your list - enclosed). The other products that you purchase from Kendall (as annotated on your enclosed list as "no") do not contain a hazardous substance as defined by the OSHA regulation and, therefore, we do not have material safety data information available.

Please be advised that this listing also covers products manufactured at our Green Bay manufacturing plant. Please also be advised that none of Kendall's products fall under DOT hazardous regulations; none require DOT Ship Name, DOT ID Number or DOT Reportable Qty.

To be considered a hazardous substance (and therefore require an MSDS), a product must have shown statistically significant evidence, based on at least one study conducted in accordance with established scientific principles, that acute or chronic health effects may occur in employees exposed to the substance, and/or present a significant physical hazard.
