To Our Valued Customers:

This letter contains important information with regards to the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65). The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) has added bisphenol A (BPA) to the list of chemicals known to the state of California to cause reproductive toxicity. The law is a warning label law, not a ban on listed substances.

BPA is the raw material that produces polycarbonate plastics and epoxy resins. Substances like BPA could fall within Safe Harbor Levels (based on dermal exposure) based on a Maximum Allowable Dose Level (MADL) established by the OEHHA of 3 micrograms per day.

Trividia Health has determined that the Lens used for our TRUE Blood Glucose Meters and the Alternate Site Cap used for TRUEplus Lancing Devices contain small levels of BPA. Dermal exposure tests conducted on these products have demonstrated these products are safe and fall within the Safe Harbor Level for dermal exposure, not exceeding the MADL of 3 micrograms per day.

Upon reviewing these product test results, Trividia Health has determined that packaging for these products does not require the Warning statement.
