Preventing Falls In Your Home

Each year, thousands of older Americans fall at home. Many of them are seriously injured, and some are disabled. In 2002, more than 12,800 people over age 65 died and 1.6 million were treated in emergency departments because of falls. Falls are often due to hazards that are easy to overlook but easy to fix. This checklist will help you find and fix those hazards in your home. The checklist asks about hazards found in each room of your home. For each hazard, the checklist tells you how to fix the problem. At the end of the checklist, you'll find other tips for preventing falls.

Look at the **STAIRS AND STEPS** you use both inside and outside your home.

Are there papers, shoes, books or other objects on the stairs?

- Pick up things on the stairs. Always keep objects off stairs.

Are some steps broken or uneven?

- Fix loose or uneven steps.

Are you missing a light over the stairway?

- Have an electrician put in an overhead light at the top and bottom of the stairs.

Do you have only one light switch for your stairs (only at the top or at the bottom of the stairs)?

- Have an electrician put in a light switch at the top and bottom of the stairs. You can get light switches that glow.

Has the stairway light bulb burned out?

- Have a friend or family member change the light bulb.

Is the carpet on the steps loose or torn?

- Make sure the carpet is firmly attached to every step, or remove the carpet and attach non-slip rubber treads to the stairs.

Are the handrails loose or broken? Is there a handrail on only one side of the stairs?

- Fix loose handrails or put in new ones. Make sure handrails are on both sides of the stairs and are as long as the stairs.

Look at the **FLOORS** in each room.

When you walk through a room, do you have to walk around furniture?

- Ask someone to move the furniture so your path is clear.

Do you have throw rugs on the floor?

- Remove the rugs or use double-sided tape or a non-slip backing so the rugs won't slip.

Are there papers, books, towels, shoes, magazines, boxes, blankets or other objects on the floor?

- Pick up things that are on the floor. Always keep objects off the floor.

Do you have to walk over or around wires or cords (e.g., lamp, telephone or extension cords)?

- Coil or tape cords and wires next to the wall so you can't trip over them. If needed, have an electrician put in another outlet.

Look at your **KITCHEN** and eating area.

Are the things you use often on high shelves?

- Move items in your cabinets. Keep things you use often on the lower shelves (about waist level).

Is your step stool unsteady?

- If you must use a step stool, get one with a bar to hold onto. Never use a chair as a step stool.

Look at all your **BATHROOMS**.

Is the tub or shower floor slippery?

- Put a non-slip rubber mat or self-stick strips on the floor of the tub or shower.

Do you need some support when you get in and out of the tub or up from the toilet?

- Have a carpenter put grab bars inside the tub and next to the toilet

Look at all your **BEDROOMS**.

Is the light near the bed hard to reach?

- Place a lamp close to the bed where it's easy to reach.

Is the path from your bed to the bathroom dark?

- Put in a night light so you can see where you're walking. Some night lights go on by themselves after dark.

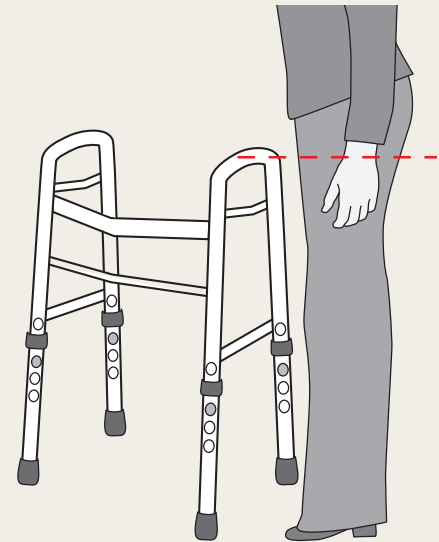
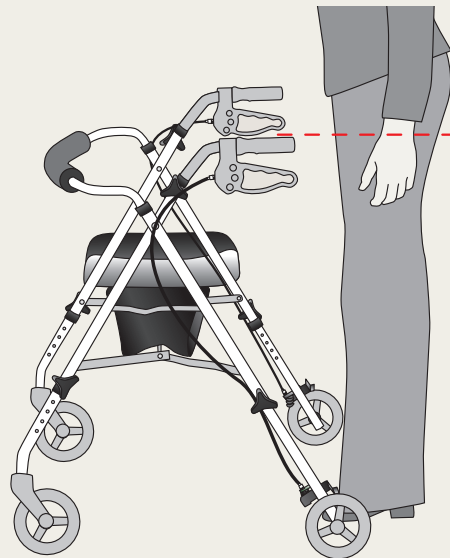
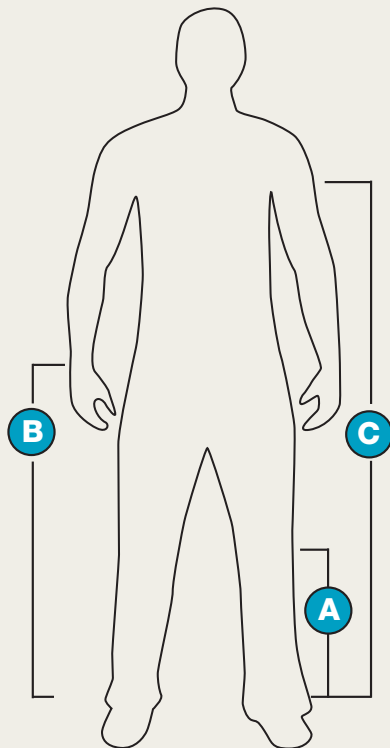

How To Adjust Your Mobility Aids

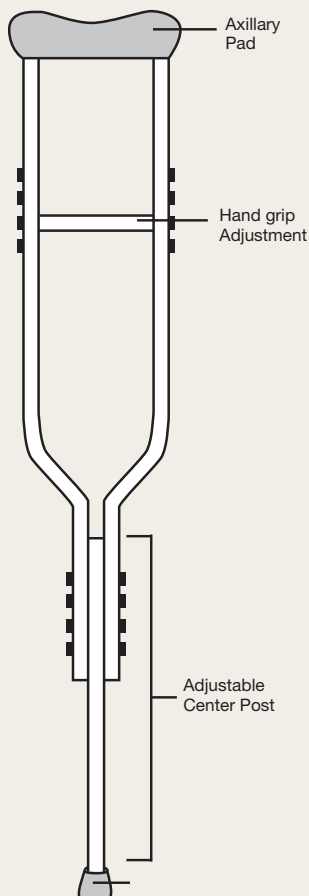


Rollators

1. Select a rollator that is appropriate to the patient's weight.
2. Measure from the ground to the crease in the back of the knee. (See A).
3. Adjust the rollator legs accordingly so the seat is at same height as A.
4. Keeping arms at your side with a natural bend at the elbow, measure from the ground to the center of the wrist. (See B).

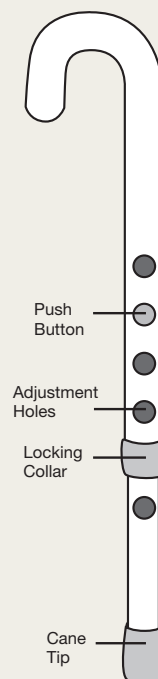
Walkers

1. Select a walker that is appropriate to the patient's weight.
2. Keeping arms at your side with a natural bend at the elbow, measure from the ground to the center of the wrist. (See B)
3. Adjust all four legs to the same height so that the handgrips match the same height as the wrist.



Axillary Crutches

1. Select a pair of crutches that is appropriate to the patient's weight.
2. For the overall crutch height, stand straight and measure from the ground to two to three inches below the axilla. The cushion should not be touching the axilla. (See C)
3. For hand grip height, keep arms at your side with a natural bend at the elbow, measure from the ground to the center of the wrist. (See B)



Canes

1. Select a cane that is appropriate to the patient's weight.
2. For the ideal cane height, keep arms at your side with a natural bend at the elbow. Measure from the ground to the center of the wrist. (See B)
3. Loosen the collar on the cane and press the push-button lock, slide the lower tube into or out of the body of the cane until you get to the wrist-height measurement, and let the push button "click" into the closest hole to the measurement. Tighten the collar (check and re-tighten the collar regularly).

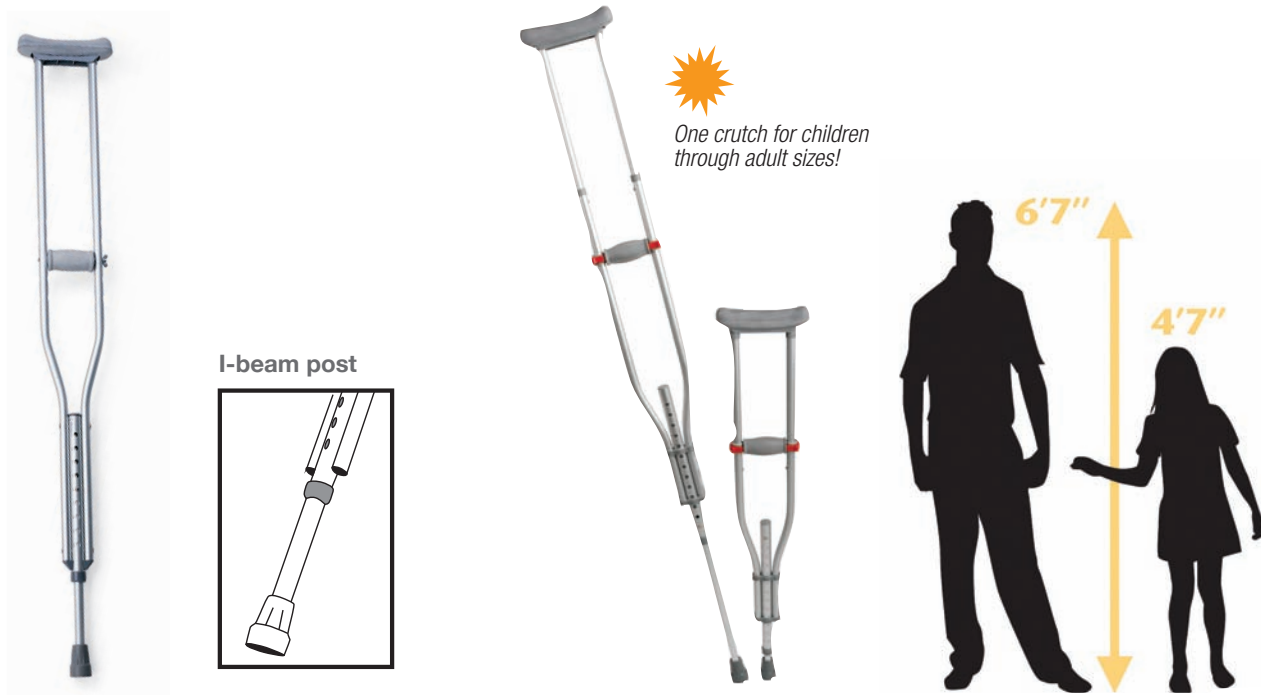

Making Your Bathroom Safer

To help provide security and stability, use the guide below to understand where bath safety products can be located in and around the bathroom.



A. Handheld Shower

Hand held showers should be used for anyone who bathes with a shower chair or transfer bench. The 86" (218 cm) long hose allows a person to remain seated while bathing.

B. Elevated Toilet Seat

When bending is difficult, using the toilet can present a potential fall risk. Using a raised toilet seat will reduce the degree of required bending, thereby reducing fall risk.

C. Bathroom Grab Bars and Assist Bars

Install grab bars in your bathroom to offer support in areas where falls are most likely to occur. These areas include anywhere that might have a wet surface or anywhere people tend to bend frequently. A grab bar's primary use is to steady the user and may not support the weight of a falling individual.

Bathtub Assist Bar – Clamps directly onto the tub wall. The assist bar helps make entry and exit safer.

Wall-Mounted Grab Bars (not shown) – Mounts directly to your wall to provide an extra grip when standing or sitting in the tub.

D. Transfer Bench

When getting in and out of the tub becomes a difficult and potentially dangerous task, transfer benches are a careful alternative. The person bathing can sit down on the outside of the bathtub, swing their legs over the wall, and then easily slide across the seat while holding onto a hand rail mounted on the opposite side.

Answers To Your Questions



How can I make it easier to get into and out of my bathtub?

A **transfer bench** straddles the side of the bathtub, allowing you to sit down outside the tub and then move over the surface of the bench into the bathtub. You may also want to consider installing grab bars on the walls of the shower/tub area.

How can I prevent falling when I am bathing or showering?

A **bath bench** can be placed inside your bathtub or shower. You can then safely sit on the bench while you wash your body. You may also want to consider installing grab bars on the walls and using a hand-held shower attachment to make showering easier.

How can I make it easier to get up from a toilet seat?

A **raised toilet seat** can easily be installed on top of your toilet seat. The advantage of a raised toilet seat is that it provides additional height, decreasing the distance you have to sit down or stand up.

How can I keep myself steady and prevent falling when I am standing in the shower?

Consider installing **grab bars** on the walls. Grab bars provide safety and support to help you maintain balance.

Health conditions can create safety challenges in the bathroom and impair your mobility. These answers can point you towards products that improve bathroom safety and enhance your mobility.

How can I keep the cast on my arm dry while I am bathing or showering?

A **cast protector** is a plastic sleeve that can be pulled over your hand and forearm, shielding your cast from the water.

How can I take care of toileting closer to my bed?

A **bedside commode** can be placed next to your bed, making it easy and accessible anytime. You can also use commode liners inside the commode bucket to make cleanup easier and sanitary.

What kind of walking aid would allow me to safely walk along outdoors, but sit down if I become tired?

A **rollator** has four wheels, handbrakes, and a padded seat on which you can sit. A rollator allows you to safely walk along, but sit on the padded seat if you become tired.

Should I use a standard wheelchair (large wheels in rear) or a transport chair (small wheels in rear)?

A **standard wheelchair** allows you to self-propel without the aid of a caregiver. Although a **transport chair** requires a caregiver to push the chair, a transport chair is smaller and lighter than a standard wheelchair—making a transport chair easier to transport in an automobile. Some people choose to own both a standard wheelchair and a transport chair, so they have the best of both worlds.

What kind of walking aid would allow me to be pushed (transported) part of the time and walk along part of the time?

A **combination transport chair/rollator** is a convenient device which converts in seconds between the modes of transport chair and rollator. You can walk along and get exercise, sit and rest when you are tired, or be pushed along with the device in transport chair mode.

ADLs are useful for people who have limited mobility or suffer from the inability to twist or bend. These personal care aids help the user maintain their dignity and independence.
